Whereas, at an election duly ordered and held in the Town of Simpsonville, in the County and State aforesaid, on the 30th day of April 1929, pursuant to ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Simpsonville, and after due notice thereof, as required by law, a majority of the qualified electors voting in said election authorized the sale of the property hereinafter described, to the Southern Public Utilities Company, upon the consideration hereinafter stated; and

Whereas, all of the requirements of law regarding the ordering and holding of said election have been fully complied with;

Now, therefore, Know All Men By These Presents That the Town of Simpsonville, a municipal corporation duly created and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the Southern Public Utilities Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maine, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, released, conveyed, set over and delivered, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, release, convey, set over and deliver unto the said Southern Public Utilities Company, its successors and assigns, all that certain electric distribution, lighting and transmission system, and all apparatus, equipment, appliances and appurtenances, and all materials and supplies connected therewith, owned by the Town of Simpsonville, including all poles, towers, wires, cross arms, insulators, supports, fastenings, transformers, meters, lamps, globes, shades, brackets, and all equipment, apparatus, appliances, fixtures, materials, supplies, and all property of every nature and description in any wise connected therewith, or incident thereto.
