*Situate, lying and being on Rutherford Road and South Tiger River. Beginning at Iron Pin in Rutherford Road and running thence 17.42 with John J. Paris line to J. P. Hollis corner, thence S. 25 1/2 W. 70 links to a Holly; thence S. 60 1/2 W. 9.50 to a pine; thence S. 72 E. 3.78 to white oak; thence N. 12 E. 1.00 to a stone on bank of Long Branch; thence down the meanderings of Long Branch to where it empties into South Tiger River; thence up said River line 27.42 to Iron Pin; thence 7.11 to Iron Pin in road; thence along said road as a line to beginning corner, containing forty four acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of John J.
