That your Petitioners believe that it would be to the interest of the trust estate and would simplify the management thereof to substitute one Trustee for the three Trustees named in the trust deeds; that Franklin Real Estate and Investment Company is a South Carolina corporation with its principal place of business at Greenville, South Carolina, and is efficiently managed by capable officials and is entirely competent to discharge the duties of such Trustee.

Wherefore your Petitioners pray that Franklin Real Estate and Investment Company be substituted as Trustee in the aforesaid trusts in the Place of H. P. McGee, C. B. Martin and B. E. Geer.

Geer, as Trustees making a proper accounting of all property and funds connected with said trusts to said Franklin Real Estate and Investment Company as Trustee, that they be discharged from any and all further liability in connection with said trusts.
