All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Scott Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about seven miles from Greenville County Court House, on the Augusta Road and having the following notes and bounds, according to a plat made by R. M. James, Engr., Sept. 1822 to wit: Beginning at an iron six in the center of the Augusta Road, corner of W. M. Ashmore's land, and running thence along the Stearns house line S. 86-30 E. 167 feet to a stone; thence continuing along the Stearns house line S. 87-10 E. 1125 feet to a stake; thence N. 87-13 E. 1452 feet to a stake in the Augusta Road; thence along the said road S. 8-100 E. 634 feet to the beginning corner and containing twenty (20) acres, more or less; this being the same land conveyed to the Saluda Real Estate Company by Jessie A. Childers by her deed dated January 2nd 1822 recorded in Plat Book 1, page 134. *F.J. 10/14/11*

Also All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Scott Township, on waters of Reedy River, containing 40 acres, more or less and has the following notes and bounds, to wit: Beginning in the center of iron bridge (known as the Ashmore Bridge) over Reedy River; thence with road S. 35 E. 2.30 chs. to bend; thence with road N. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5 chs. to bend; thence with road N. 48 E. 1.40 chs. to bend; thence with road N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.40 chs. to bend; thence with road N. 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.50 chs. to bend; thence with road N. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.60 chs. to bend in road; thence with road S. 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.68 chs. to bend in road; thence S. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 22.30 chs. to bend in fork of branches; thence down said branch 22.41 chs. the branch as a line to the river; thence to said Reedy River at the beginning corner, adjoining lands of R.
