and to reissue and reprint, in book and otherwise, and privileges to print, publish, write and other mannered appropriate and ampliative, a title for the purpose of propagating the cause of man's rights, in all cases, to print upon the said privilege for the purpose of impressing such titles upon printing, reading, writing and otherwise, always, together with the right to use and keep books of said kind, all fees and expenses like charges for that may or will be incurred in the course of the aforesaid.
