in City of Greenville, and being known and designated
as lot no 2, according to Plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engi-
neer, March 1923, and recorded in the office of the Register
of Deeds Correspondence for Greenville County, South Carolina
in Plat Book F at page 104, and having the following
metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern
side of Elm Street joint corners of lots nos 1 and 2,
and running thence with the joint lines of said
lots S. 65-33 E. 172.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S.
36-15 E. 65 feet to another iron pin, corners of lots nos
2 and 3; thence with joint line of said lots N.
62-17 E. 170.7 feet to an iron pin on Elm Street,
joint corners of lots 2 and 3; thence with southwestern
side of Elm Street N. 36-15 E. 65 feet to the point of
beginning.

The grantee herein agrees and assumes to pay the
mortgage executed by Albert G. Smith to Union Fruit Com-
pany of Maryland and The South Carolina National
