to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Trapp and Charles Henry Trapp

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. W. D. Trapp and Charles Henry Trapp all that piece parcel or lot of land in North Township Greenville Co., State of South Carolina, situated about seven miles from Greenville Court house on the Grove Road, and having the following metes and bounds, according to survey of W. L. Mitchell, Surveyor, Oct. 11, 1921 to wit:

Beginning at the iron pin in the road mentioned above, thence $S 22^{\circ} W. 7.24$ to an iron pin 34 old, thence $S 85^{\circ} W. 13.13$ to an iron pin 34 old, bounded by these two lines by Mrs. Nora B. McDaniel; thence $N. 11$ and $710 W. 21.75$ to a new corner on the South West side of the branch, thence $N. 58^{\circ} E. 6.89$ to an iron pin 34 old, bounded by B. P. Mitchell, thence $S 5^{\circ} W. 6.77$ to a corner in the branch; thence up said branch about 7.00 to a new corner in said branch, thence $S 10^{\circ} W. 2.59$ to a stake 34 new on a ditch; thence up said ditch $S 20^{\circ} E. 6.1$ lengths to an angle, thence $S 3^{\circ} E. 5.10$ to an angle, thence $S 4^{\circ} E. 3.17$ to a new corner in the road, thence along said road $N. 69^{\circ} E. 6.87$ to an iron pin 34 old in said road, bounded on the last seven lines by a tract sold to J. H. Harbin and on south by Nora B. McDaniel, containing 22.9 acres more or less being a part of the land conveyed to me by B. P. Mitchell.

Also: all that other tract of land having the following metes and bounds, according to survey made by W. L. Mitchell Oct. 11th, 1921, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of B. M. Harrison's land and the above mentioned tract of land running $S. 5^{\circ} W. 6.44$ to a rock; thence $S 85^{\circ} E. 8.55$ to a spruce pine; thence $N 11^{\circ} 7 W. 10.89$ to a stake near the branch; thence $S. 58^{\circ} W. 6.89$ to the beginning corner and being the land conveyed to me by B. P. Mitchell, said tract above described contains $6\frac{1}{4}$ acres, more or less, bounded by lands of M. R. Harrison, Robert Rosemond and others, and on branch tributary to Stone Creek.
