

Five and in consideration of one and no/100
 dollar, payment of which is hereby acknow-
 ledged, we the undersigned, Parker School Dis-
 trict, hereby grant and convey unto the Postal
 Telegraph Cable Company, its successors and
 assigns, the right, privilege and authority to
 construct, operate, and maintain its lines of
 telegraph and telephony, including the necessary
 poles, wires, cables and fixtures upon, over
 and across the land which we own, or in
 which we have an interest, in the County of
 Greenville, and State of South Carolina, which
 right-of-way may be identified as follows:

1. Grounds known as Parker High School, adjoin-
 ing Bramlett Street, City View.
 This right-of-way is permission to erect
 one line of poles only
 and upon and along the roads, streets or high-
 ways in front of or adjoining said land, with
 the right to permit the attachment of the wires
 and cables of any other company, and the right
 to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep
 the wires and cables cleared, at least eighteen
 inches, and to erect and set the necessary
 guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach
 thereto the necessary-guy wires.
