Scott, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, on the south side of East North Street Extension, being designated as Lot No. 2 of the property of George Norwood, as shown on plat of said property made Nov. 1928, by W. M. Rast, Eng., and being a part of Lot No. 52 of Overbrook Subdivision as shown on plat of said subdivision, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Part Book 6, page 202, and having, according to said plat the following lines and bounds.

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of East North Street Extension 60 feet east from the corner of lot No. 50 of Overbrook Subdivision, thence S. 8-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-04 E. 58.6 feet; thence N. 7-41 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on East North Street Extension; thence along the line of said street S. 76-04 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay a first mortgage and note in the sum of \$3000.00 executed by the Greenville Realty and Building Company to W. M. Ramsey and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County. Also a second note and mortgage given by the grantee to The Greenville Realty and Building Co. in the sum of \$2000.00 dated March 23rd, 1929 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in book 217 at page 10.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by The Greenville Realty and Building Company on the 23rd day of March 1929, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in book 12, page 546.
