day of December 1930 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was  
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to J. M. Byrd

Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$50.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said J. M. Byrd

"All of the right, title and interest of Grace Glenn Ray, the same being an undivided one-third (1/3) interest, in and to the following described real estate:

all those certain lots of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and in the subdivision shown as Crusby Heights, the said lots being designated as Lot nos 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, as shown on a plat of the same made by C. M. Furness Jr. Engineer, November, 1930, and said lots having in the aggregate the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the corner of Avenue A and the south side of Hall Street and running thence along the line of Hall Street S 66-30° W 322 feet to the joint corner of lot nos 6 and 7; thence along the front line of said lot S 23-30° E 100 feet to the rear corner of Lot nos 17 and 18, thence along the rear line of the lot herein conveyed N. 66-30° E. 250 feet to an iron pin on Avenue A 123.2 feet to the beginning corner. Being a portion of the property known as the Thos. H. Glenn Estate."
