Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said P. H. Shackleton,

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in  
Dunbar Mountain Township, Greenville County, S 6 on the  
Duncan Chapel Road and having the following metes and  
bounds according to a plat and survey made by W. J. Riddle  
surveyor January, 1932 to wit:

Beginning at the center of a bridge situate at a point  
where the Duncan Chapel road crosses a creek and at the  
corner of the Watkins land, and running thence in a  
northerly direction with said creek as the line 25-45, more  
or less, to point in creek corner of W. C. Hawkins land,  
thence with line of Hawkins land N. 44 W. 15-60 feet to a  
stone, thence N. 57 W. 16-12 feet to a stone corner of Mrs. F. S.  
Moody land, thence with the line of said Moody land S 44-15  
W. 27-08 feet to a oak bush on the Duncan Chapel road, thence  
S. 14 E. 14-0 feet thence S. 29-45 E. 2-39 feet, S 50 E. 19-3 feet;  
thence S. 59-30 E. 2-80 feet; thence S. 80-15 E. 2-37 feet to a pin;  
thence S. 10-30 E. 4-07-5 feet; thence S. 15-15 E. 16-2 feet, due south  
31-3 feet; thence S. 11-15 W. 1-90 feet, thence S. 75-20 E. 6-0-6 feet,  
to an iron pin on the G. & N. Railroad thence N. 6-20 E. 8-00  
feet to pin on said Duncan Chapel road, thence S. 80-15 E.  
3-94 feet; thence S. 64 E. 1-88 feet to center of Duncan Chapel  
Road, thence S. 17-45 E. 3-63 feet, thence S. 42 E. 6-33 feet, thence  
S. 52 E. 3-41 feet; thence S. 61-45 E. 3-98 feet, thence S. 67-30 E.  
13-70 feet to the beginning corner, containing 23 1/2 acres, more
