Whereas, Rebecca S. Lupo, Individually and as Administratrix of the Estate of P. D. Lupo, deceased,

on or about the 3rd, day of December, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty one, exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Thomas Lupo, Helen Lupo, Perry Lupo, Alfred Lupo, and Bettie Lupo.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint, the same being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th day of February 1932 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Rebecca S. Lupo, Alfred Lupo, Perry Lupo, and Bettie Lupo. for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-2690.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Rebecca S. Lupo, an undivided two-fifths interest and unto Alfred Lupo, Perry Lupo and Bettie Lupo, each, an undivided one-fifth interest in and to the following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land just outside the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, being Lot No. 16 situate on the East side of Jones Avenue, and fronting said street seventy feet and running back on southern line 183.5 feet, northern line 186.6 feet, and 70.18 feet on back as shown by plat made by R. E. Dalton for W. C. McDaniel, January 1924, to which reference is made as a part of this description. Said lot being conveyed to P. D. Lupo by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 91, at page 141."
