according to City Block Book for 1924;

Beginning at the southwest corner of Jenkins St. and Batson Alley and running thence
with Jenkins St. in a westerly direction 90.5 feet to lot of Henry Briggs; thence with line
of Henry Briggs in a southerly direction 213 feet; thence in a easterly direction 87 feet
to Batson Alley; thence with Batson Alley 213 feet to the beginning corner, being part of
