on or about the 31st day of January in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-four exhibited their petition complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Lydia Wash. Henson (Tawler), Nettie Bell Henson, W. J. Fisher and Helen J. Fisher

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 12th day of Feb 1934, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Lumsan Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. J. NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Lumsan Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said W. J. Fisher and Helen Fisher

the following described property to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in the Town of Green, S.C., fronting on Hubert St. and bounded by corners of McElrath, Foster, Wood and the said Hubert St. and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at Wood's corner on Hubert St. and running thence with his line 176 ft. to Foster's line, thence with his line 15 ft.; thence with McElrath's line 196 ft. to the said Hubert St.; thence with the said St. to the beginning corner, said lot containing 34.00 square ft., more or less. Being the same lot conveyed to W. J. Henson by G. P. Mills and Marvin R. Reese, by deed dated July 29, 1916, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 39 at page 578.
