TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

Whereas, Nora B. McDaniel

on or about the 27th day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirtysix exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against W. Carroll Brown, as Trustee under the will of the late William Carroll Brown

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 10th day of October 1936, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Nora B. McDaniel for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. 6-6260)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Nora B. McDaniel, her heirs and assigns:

All that tract of land known as tract no. 1 in the partition or allocations as made by Commissioners and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a hickory (gone) at the corner of the J. D. Harris land and thence N. 71. W 14. 53 crossing a road to a stake; thence N. 31. 30 E. 13. 28 to an iron pin; thence N. 53 W 64. 80 to an iron pin in Sonestee Road; thence along and in said road and continuing beyond the same in a line N. 84 E 37. 43 to a stake; thence N. 20. 30 E. 9. 35 to a stake in said Sonestee Road; thence N. 1. 30 E. 8. 65 to a chestnut stump (gone); thence thence S. 88. 30 E. 19. 00 to a stake in Sonestee Road; thence N. 89. 30 E. 7. 88 to a post oak; thence S. 23. 45 W 44. 14 to a large dead chestnut; thence S. 65. 30 E. 8. 35 to a cherry tree (gone); thence S. 16. 30 W crossing a road 30. 31 to the beginning corner, and containing 178 acres, more or less.
