J. S. Bennett, Julia A. Garrison, Jamie A. Mastin and
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

E. W. Bennett, their heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate,
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, herein
below described, in the following undivided portions to wit:
To T. D. Bennett $\frac{3}{4}$ of the whole and to each of the
others $\frac{1}{4}$ of the whole making a total of $\frac{1}{2}$.

Beginning at a persimmon stump 3x0m on said
river and running thence N. 71 E. 39.00 to a Red Oak stump
3x0m, thence N. 29 E. 31.50 to a Dogwood 3x0m, thence N.
23 E. 45.00 to a stake 3x0m, near pine stump, thence N. 25 E.
15.00 to a stake 3x0m, thence S. 42 E. 21.20 to a Spanish Oak
stump 3x0m, thence S. 88 E. 47.15 to a stake 3x0m, thence S.
15 E. 39.75 to a poplar 3x0m, thence S. 86 E. 13.90 to the
said river; thence down the said river to the beginning,
containing three ninety-one (391) acres, more or less,
except a tract of seventy (70) acres devised under the
will of J. B. Bennett, deceased to T. D. Bennett, which
said acres have been duly set apart to the said T. D.
Bennett and a plat showing the same has been
