All that certain lot or parcel of land situate

containing one and two hundredth acres
more or less, and being more fully described

Beginning at an iron pin on the south
side of the Old Hobick Springs Road at the center
of Point Mill Street and running thence along
the center of said street S. 19.55 E. 224 ft. to an
