Kirkland and designated as Tract No. 2 of the subdivision of the lands  
of Martha A. Austin as shown by plat of said lands, and being more  
particularly described by Metes and Bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a pin in road on Tanners line; thence N. 72 $\frac{1}{2}$  E.  
20.63 to pine stump; thence S. 20 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 11.05 to stone; thence S. 68 $\frac{3}{4}$
