in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said John L. McKinney, his Heirs and assigns.
All of our right, title and interest in and to
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal.....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on Enorre River and Long Branch, beginning at a stone on left bank of Enorre River (corner of Y. P. Styles) and running thence N. 9 W. 14.37 ch. to stake; thence N. 1. W. 7.83 ch. to a stake in a road; thence along said road, S. 89 W. 8.75 ch. to a Red Oak on North side of road; thence N. 6 E. 45.70 ch. to a stone; thence N. 52 1/2 E. 10.50 ch. to a Black Gum on Long Branch; thence down and with the meanderings of said Long Branch to Enoree River; thence up and with the meanderings of Enoree River to the beginning corner. Containing one hundred and eighty-one (181) acres, more or less. Adjoining the lands of Y. P. Styles and others.
