This cause coming on for trial at September Term 1931 of Rowan Superior Court, before His Honor, P. D. Mr. Gray, Judge Presiding, and it appearing to the Court that the defendant is a non-resident, but that summons has been properly served as provided by law and adjudication of service has heretofore been made by this Clerk of the Superior Court of Rowan County, and this cause being tried by the Court and a jury and the issues having been submitted to and answered by the jury as follows, to-wit:

1. Were the plaintiff, Henry Free, and the defendant, Martha Meadows Free, married to each other, as alleged in the complaint?

Answer: yes.

2. Has the plaintiff been a resident of the State of North Carolina, County of Rowan, for two years next preceding the commencement of this action?

Answer: yes.

3. Did the defendant Martha Meadows Free, commit adultery with one Henry Green, as alleged in the complaint?

Answer: yes.

4. Did the defendant commit adultery with one Henry Palmore, as alleged in the complaint.

Answer: yes.

It is now, on motion of P. S. Barton, Counsel for plaintiff, Ordered And Adjudged that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the plaintiff, Henry Free, and the defendant Martha Meadows Free, be and the same are hereby dissolved, and that the plaintiff
