all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the subdivision known as "Glenn Grove Park" and known and designated as Lot #71, on Plat of "Glenn Grove" recorded in R. M. C. office for said County in Plat Book "P", at page 233; the courses and distances being as follows: beginning on east side of McAdoo Ave. at corner of Monticello Ave. and running thence along McAdoo Ave.
