all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Paris Mountain,** Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

containing **21.35** acres, more or less, having the following notes and bounds, according to a survey made by **C. M. Furman,** Tr.

Beginning at a stake at the joint corner of property belonging to **W. M. Glenn, C. W. Casem** and **W. W. Griffin** and thence running **S. 13 1/2 E. 338** feet along a small branch to a stake; thence **S. 40 E. 234** feet to a stake; thence **S. 11-45 E. 340** feet to a stake; thence **N. 79-30 W. 550** feet to a stake; thence **S. 8-16 W. 565** feet to a stake; thence **S. 77 1/2 W. 520** feet to a stake at a poplar on a branch thence by the meanders of said branch in a northerly direction about **1400** feet to a stake in the said branch at the joint corner of **Duncan Dial** and **W.
