KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, H. H. Griffis,

In the State aforesaid,

In consideration of the sum of One
and exchange of property of equal value
to me paid by Emelyne P. Mcgee.

In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emelyne P. Mcgee,
all that given, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

one tract or parcel known as Melrose Land Company,
being known and designated as a part of lot no 6
on plat made by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor, dated January
1872, said plat being separate and distinct from Melrose
Land Company Plat, said survey and plat made by R. E.
Dalton being for the estate of W. F. Goddard, deceased, said lot
having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at the tree post on the northeast corner
of Walnut and Beacon Streets and running thence
north Beacon Street N. 16-50 E. 65.66 feet to a pine,
thence S. 72-29 E. 143.7 feet to another pine, thence S.
15-37 E. 63.9 feet to a pine on Walnut Street, thence
with Walnut Street N. 73-10 W. 150 feet to the begin-
ning corner. Less however that portion of said
lot which was conveyed by grantee herein to
quarter herein by deed dated April 26, 1935, and
the lot conveyed by said deed be excepted from
this conveyance. It is the intention of this conveyance to con-
vey all that remains of said lot not after the conveyance
aforementioned.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Jesse L. Foosett on the 22nd day of December 1930, deed recorded in office of Register
of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 139, Page 251.

appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Emelyne P. Mcgee, her
heirs and assigns forever.

I, Jesse L. Foosett, do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to
warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Emelyne P. Mcgee, her
heirs and assigns, against any and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or for ever to seize on any part thereof.
