Lot M. 26 according to a plat made by L. M. Fierman, Engineer,  
April, 1925, said plat being recorded in Plat Book 1, Page  
278, and having a frontage of 70.1 feet on Edwards Street,  
reference to said plat being made for further descrip-  
tion. Being the same property conveyed to me, the said  
J. B. Warren, by J. E. Shirey by deed dated March 8, 1926, re-  
corded in Book 106, page 3439.

With full power unto said trustee to collect the rents and  
profits arising from the aforesaid property, and out of  
the proceeds thereof to pay the taxes, fire insurance, in-  
terest and principal of a certain note and mortgage ex-  
ecuted by me to Mechanics Building and Loan Association
