All that certain lot of land situate in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville State of South Carolina, having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Rutherford Road, Q. A. Green's corner, and running thence with Q. A. Green's line S. 79° E. 7.00 chains to stone by W. O.; thence S. 3 W. 6.00 to stone by W. O.; S. 88° E. 12.30 to pin; thence N. 4 E. 13.13 to iron pin; new mark; thence with line of land retained by the Grantor, N. 89 W. 9.43 to stake; thence N. 41½ W. 12.00 to iron pin; thence N. 64 W. 6.28 to iron pin on Rutherford Road; thence with said Road in a Southerly direction, 10.89 to the beginning corner, containing 28½ acres. More or less, as shown by survey and plat made by W. A. Hester Oct. 20th, 1920, and being a portion of the land conveyed to T.
