(We the parties whereunto hereby acknowledge both these Grants, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Harry J. Beeson and Elizabeth M. Hossey, their heirs and assigns, all that lot of land, situate in the City and County of Greenville, S.C., on the west side of West Earle Street, known and designated as a part of the Southern half of lot No. 1, according to plan recorded in the S. W. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book 6, page 157,

beginning at a point on said West Earle Street 256 feet east of the northeast intersection of Rutherford and Earle Streets abiding thence with Earle Street S. 36° 05' E. 50 feet to a pin, corner of lot No. 2; thence with line of lot No. 2 N. 1° 05' W. 208 feet to a pin, thence N. 36° 15' W. 50 feet to a pin, thence S. 1° 05' W. 208 feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of the land conveyed to me by said record Vol. 113, page 71.

This deed is made subject to the driveway eight feet wide. The Western line of the aforesaid lot, running S. 1° 05' W., to be the center of said driveway so that said driveway shall consist of a strip four feet wide from the western side of the lot aforesaid, extending back 128 feet and a strip four feet wide from the eastern lot adjoining the land above described, extending back 128 feet, which said driveway is referred to and the rights therein conveyed in deed recorded Vol. 124, page 348. Said driveway to be for the joint use, as a driveway, of the owners, their heirs and assigns, and for occupants of the land hereinabove described and the lot adjoining thereto on the West, and aforesaid to.
