(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Nora N. Roe, and her heirs and assigns forever, all my one-half undivided interest in all that piece, parcel or tract of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on waters of Mushy Creek, containing 177½ acres, more or less, bounded by lands, now or formerly owned by W. H. Cerry, John Neves, Mrs. Pearson, Dr., F. E. Wood, et al., being the place formerly known as the Dr. Miles Place, and being the homestead of L. H. Skumate at the time of his death. Being the same tract of land conveyed to Helen R. Thackston and Boyce Roe by Lucinda V. Neves by her deed bearing date of March 20th, 1929, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Vol. 148, at page 299, and being the same tract of land formerly conveyed to Lucinda V. Neves by W. T. Skumate as Executor, by his deed bearing date of December 15th, 1898, recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. 000, at page 598.

Also all my one-half undivided interest in the three tracts of land hereinafter described which were conveyed to Helen R. Thackston and Boyce T. Roe by Lucinda V. Neves and T. P. Neves by their deed bearing date of May 14th, 1929, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Vol. 148, at page 97.

No. 1

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina on waters of Mash Creek, containing 29½ acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Lucinda V. Neves and T. P. Neves by deed dated Nov. 14th, 1905, and recorded in R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book, Vol. RRR, at page 95.

No. 2.

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated in the County and State aforesaid, Highland Township, on the South side of Mush Creek Road, containing 18 acres, more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to T. P. Neves by Mrs. M. A. Pearson by deed dated October 22nd, 1910, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. 9, at page 236.

All that other tract of land situated in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Highland Township, on the West side of the State Road, about eighteen miles from the Greenville County Court House, containing six (6) acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to T. P. Neves, by M. A. Pearson by deed dated September 23rd, 1922, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. 78, at page 350.
