All our right, title and interest in and to, that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying in Oneal Township, Greenville County, on the head waters of Enoree River, containing eleven (11.00) acres, more or less and having the following courses and distances and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron stake on South side of County Highway, at the line of Earnest Sammons, thence S. 87 E. with the line of Earnest Sammons 15.50 to an iron pin, thence S. 16 E. 5.20 chs., to iron pin, thence N. 24 E. 9.40 chs. to iron pin at corner of tract No. 4, (Now belonging to Miss Mauds Meece) thence N. 83 W. with line of tract No. 4, 17.31 chs. to iron stake on south side of County Highway, thence S. 32 W. with edge of said road 5.75 chs., to beginning corner; Being a part of the estate lands of Geo.
