All that certain tract and parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Oreal Township, on Beaver Dam Creek, waters of Middle Tiger River, and bounded by lands formerly owned by Ambrose Williams, and Whilden, and having the following mates and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on the old Williams and R. F. Whilden corner 36.14 chs. up to a rock corner, and runs thence S. 87 1/2 W. 14.10 chs. thence S. 24 E. 27.16 chs. to line on old Patterson Grant, thence S. 79 E. 7.32 chs. thence N. 24 W. 59.32 chs. to the beginning corner, and being the same tract of land described in a deed from W. P. Bomar to Gilbert J. Whilden and DeLeon Whilden, containing thirty six 36 acres, more or less.
