Groce's property, S. 41-49 W. 83.2 feet to 1. p.; thence S. 45-55 E. 17.4 feet to 1. p.; thence S. 43-24 W. 45 feet to 1. p. rear corner of Lewis and Jane King's property; thence along rear line of said property, S. 45-45 E. 33.6 feet to 1. p.; thence continuing with same property S. 39-45 W. 129 feet to the beginning corner.

Also the lot lying in the rear of Bassie V. Pettus lot on Washington street containing 3,512 square feet, more or less, and having a width of 32 feet with a length of 109 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, more or less, and bounded as follows: On the south by William Milan's lot (formerly J. E. Martin); on the east by lot of Mrs. M. L. Gunn; on the north by garden fence of Bassie V. Pettus, as at present located; and on the West by lot of C. S. West.* The above described lots adjoin each other and are designated on the City Plat Book at page 53 in Block 3, as lots numbers 16 and 22 respectively and are the same two lots conveyed to the grantee, the said T. P. West, by C. S. West by deed recorded in R. W. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 108, page 131.

It is understood and agreed that the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the mortgage over said property executed by T. P. West to the American Building & Loan Association June 23, 1929, and recorded in said R. W. C. Office in Book 221, page 215, on which there is now due the sum of \$300.00, but the taxes over said property for the year 1933 are to be prorated as of the date of the execution of this doc.
