Whereas, C. W. Biggs, died leaving his last will and testament, dated July 22, 1932, which has been duly admitted to probate by the Probate Judge of said Greenville County, and

Whereas, Lydia Blanch Biggs is his widow, Hapson L. Biggs is his son and Edna May Biggs is his daughter, and they constitute his sole heirs at law and distributees and

Whereas, subsequent to the making of said will and a few days before the said C. W. Biggs died, he expressed the will and desire that said will be abrogated and that his property be distributed equally, share and share alike, one-third to his said widow, one-third to his said son and one-third to his said daughter, now,

Therefore, in order to effectuate the true intention of the said C. W. Biggs, and for value received, the said Lydia Blanch Biggs, Edna May Biggs and Hapson L. Biggs, do hereby agree that said will shall be abrogated to the extent that all of the parties shall equally share in the property of said C. W. Biggs, after the payment of his debts, and that said Edna May Biggs shall execute a deed conveying unto her mother, Lydia Blanch Biggs, and unto Hapson L. Biggs, one-third interest each in the land and real estate owned by the estate of C. W. Biggs, deceased, and also the personal property owned by the said estate. But it is agreed among the said parties, for the purposes of the administration of the said estate, that the said Edna May Biggs shall act as Executor under said will that said will shall not be declared void, but modified under this agreement among all parties in interest.
