That said J.B. Ricketts and H.J. Shackster shall not be responsible for any money & cest that which actually comes into their hands nor for any debt that may accumulate & not paid.

This agreement is upon the further consideration that no proceeding to foreclose said mortgage shall be instituted within one year after this date, provided said rents are applied as above stipulated.

The space occupied by H.J. Shackster as an office, excepted from the terms hereof.

The terms of this instrument shall extend to and beyond the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the owners of said property and of the said indebtedness shall not terminate in any way.
