State, we acknowledge of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00), paid by State Commissioner of Forestry, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, granted to said State Commissioner of Forestry, its executors and assigns, the right, privilege and convenience to construct, operate and maintain a telephone line for West Protection, including all telephone and other wires, poles, attachments, equipment and accessories desirable or convenient there-with, over, upon, and across the following described tract or parcel of land known as Cleveland Road in or near the town of Cleveland School District, Cleveland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and adjoining the lands of Wm. D. Beer and others; the cause heretofore located and marked out for such construction, aforesaid and maintenance, being described as follows:

Beginning at property line of B. G. Beer running East & West along back side of his property to telephone in 771 Charles Street, a distance of approximately one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) mile together with the right to extend, inspect, alter, improve, repair, relocate, along the route above described, and remove such lines, wires, poles, attachments, equipment and accessories, including the right to increase or decrease number of wires, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, for the purpose above described, including the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth along said line, and all trees and other obstructions adjacent thereto, that may, in any way endanger the proper operation of same, including also the right to enter over adjoining lands of grantor.
