Mildred Knittle, Filda Harrison, Allie Hughes  
and Ernest Pitman for love and affection  
do hereby grant, bargain and release unto  
Jane Pitman and mother who is the law-  
ful wife of the said S. A. Pitman deceased,  
during her natural life time all and each  
of any interest in and to all property belong-  
ing to our father the said S. A. Pitman at  
his decease, both personal and real estate, and  
we do release our interest to her our mother  
for the purpose that she may maintain  
herself and give her support during her  
natural life time from the real estate of the  
said S. A. Pitman at his decease and from  
whosoever the real estate may produce, which  
real estate is described as follows:

All that piece or parcel of land described  
in a deed conveyed by Anderson Pitman to  
S. A. Pitman in County of Laurens, State of South  
Carolina, in the township of Liberty, filed and  
recorded the 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1908. Recorded  
in Vol. 7, P. 21 in Book 2, Page 143, contain-  
ing one hundred acres. Also that piece or  
parcel of land described in a deed from  
James Rossell to S. A. Pitman, filed 30<sup>th</sup> day  
of Sept. 1912. Recorded in Vol. 21, p. 198. Entered  
in record 30<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1912 in book 7 page  
257, containing two lots in said deed. The first  
7 1/4 Second 4 1/2 Acres. In State and County and  
township aforesaid.

deed from Robby Pitman, H. C. Pitman, Mary  
Moon and Hattie Hart to S. A. Pitman filed 14<sup>th</sup>  
day of Dec. 1908, recorded in G. O. P. page 379, En-

to the said premises belonging to the said

And we the above named children of the said  
S. A. Pitman deceased, as heirs to the above described  
real estate, do hereby sign and relinquish our  
rights as heirs to the above described real  
estate to Jane Pitman, who is the legal wife  
of the said S. A. Pitman and our lawful mother  
during her natural life time.
