And it is expressly agreed by and between the parties to this agreement that time is of the essence of this agreement, and unless the aforesaid purchase price is paid at the times hereinabove set forth, the party of the first part shall have the right to repossess the property and retain Two Hundred dollars of the amount paid, as liquidated damages; and the party of the first part will be absolutely discharged in law and equity from any and all liability to make and execute said deed, and may treat the party of the second part as a tenant holding over after the expiration of his lense; or, if he desires so to do, may enforce the payment of the purchase money; and in the event he should exercise his right to enforce the payment of the purchase money, all deferred payments shall bear interest at the rate of 8% per annum, to be computed and paid annually.
