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FIRST: All expenses incurred in paying the taxes and keeping up the property;
Second: All advances which have been made, including interest; and if there is anything remaining from the proceeds, such amount is then to be divided in accordance with instructions contained in my Will.

The said Trustee is fully authorized and empowered to do any and all things, and to execute any and all papers for all purposes, as fully as I myself could do, were I present.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said J. Foster Lupo, as Trustee, his Heirs, and Assigns, against me and my Heirs and Assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
