Seaborn corner, running thence with his line S. 45 E. 5.58 to stone; thence N. 69 E. 24.85 to stone; thence N. 34 3/4 W. 1.70 to sweet gum stump; thence N. 62 1/4 E. 25.00; thence N. 2 W. 7.00 to poplar; thence S. 62 3/4 W. 54.18 to iron pin, beginning corner, bounded by J. C. Cothran, Mayor Abner, Columbus Cooley, and E. W. Seaborn, and containing 34 acres more or less.
