in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Langley, W. Homer Langley, and Mabel L. Taylor, their heirs and assigns forever all our right, title and interest in and to Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in:

"All that certain lot situate in Ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the west side of Rutherford Street, having a frontage of 70 feet and being the same property conveyed to Henry M. Langley by St. Wood on December 15, 1914, by deed recorded in Volume 57, at page 228, said R. M. C. Office, reference to which is hereby made for a more definite description by metes and bounds:

Also all that certain piece or parcel situate in Greenville Township, near the city limits of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, in the sub-division known as Park Place, being Lot no 13 of Block C, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book A, at page 119, said R. M. C. Office, said lot having a frontage of 50 feet on Mahon Street, and being the same lot conveyed to H. M. Langley by C. J. Langley on November 8, 1921 by deed recorded in Deed Book 78 at page 60.

The above lots are part of the estate of Henry M. Langley, deceased, and were conveyed by W. Homer Langley as executor to the grantee and the grantors on May 18, 1932 by deed recorded in Volume 144 at page 112"
