at the place named or lot of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon situated in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 19 of the "North Hills" property of Title Guarantee and Trust Company (which subdivision lies partly within and partly just outside the present city limits of Greenville), according to a plat thereof made by R. E. Dalton, dated April 1935, and recorded in the office of R. L. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book "H", at page 92, and having, according to said plat, the following rates and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the west side of Bennett Street, 140 feet south of Russell Avenue; thence along line of Lot No. 18, N. 70-30 W. 165 feet; thence S. 19-30 W. 70 feet to a rear corner of Lot No. 20; thence with a line of Lot No. 20, S. 70-30 E. 165 feet to a stake on Bennett Street; thence with Bennett Street, N. 19-30 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
