In consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars paid to me by Brandon Corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, Mealon G. McDaniel, the owner of lands on and near Reedy River in the County and State aforesaid, (including lands which I received from my father, Luther E. Green, referred to in the second item of the will of the said Luther E. Green and described in a certain unrecorded deed executed by him July 31, 1911, purporting to convey the same to me as follows:--

"All of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situated in the State and County aforesaid on Reedy River about nine miles above the city near the White Horse Road, adjoining lots Nos. 5 and 7 and having the following metes and bounds:--

"Beginning at a stake on Reedy River, corner of Lot No. 3, and thence N. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 5.10 to a stake; thence S. 79 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 8.35 to stone; thence N. 42 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2.50 to stone; thence S. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.60 to pine stump; thence N. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 40.74 to stone on new road; thence down said road S. 51 E. 6.30 to angle in road; thence S. 76 E. 11.35 to angle in road; thence S. 25 E. 3.25 to angle; thence S. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 4.28 to angle; thence S. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.85 to angle; thence S. 5 E. 3.82 to center of bridge over Reedy River; thence down the meanderings of said river about 19.00 to the beginning, containing sixty-five and one-half acres, more or less, and known as Lot No. 6 in plat made by W. A. Adams; the above land was a part of a tract purchased by me (L. E. Green) from my father in 1899 and recorded in U. U. page 685;"

do hereby release Brandon Corporation from any liability on account of, or growing out of, the construction, maintenance and operation by Brandon Corporation of a sewage and waste disposal system, including sewage disposal plant and bleaching and dye waste holding and settling basins and pipe lines emptying into Reedy River at or near its plant and property near Travelers Rest in the County and State aforesaid, and above but not touching the lands owned by me, and do hereby grant unto Brandon Corporation, its successors and assigns, the right and easement to maintain and operate a sewage and waste disposal system and to empty into Reedy River above my said lands the effluent therefrom.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend the rights and interests herein granted unto Brandon Corporation, its successors and assigns, against me, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming.
