At any time, arten the Purchaser has said as much as one half or the principal amount due, and all imperest paid to date, and has complied with the provisions herein asto payment of taxes and insurance, the Saller will give and Purchaser a fee simple general warranty deed and appears patchase money first portuge over the property nersin conveyed, which mortgage shall provide for payment of taxes, insurance as here inabove set dorth. The Purchaser shall have the ortion to anticipate any and all payments on this contract at any time.
