Beattie, of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, do hereby vest in my two sons above named all right, title and interest which I have in all of my personal property, of every nature and kind, including rents from real estate, as trustees, with the following duties and powers:

To collect the income therefrom giving receipts in my name when necessary and to pay from said income all of my expenses of every kind and to make such bequests as I may determine and designate.

Their authority as trustees is limited to the income from my personal property and no power or authority is given herein for them to sell, dispose or encumber any portion thereof, unless in their judgment it be deemed necessary or advisable.

This trust agreement may be terminated by me at any time I see fit to do so by and with the consent of the Trustees, and it will be absolutely terminated upon my death. Upon my death the disposition of my property shall be made according to such will as I may leave or, in the absence of a will, by the Statute of Distributions of South Carolina.
