All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, at the northeast corner of the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and Washington Avenue, and being more particularly described according to plat of property of Estate of John B. Marshall made by Dalton & Nease, Engineers, January 1935, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the northeast corner of the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and Washington Avenue and running thence with the north side of Easley Bridge Road N. 71-25 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 21-38 W. 180 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 71-38 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Washington Avenue; thence with the east side of said Avenue S. 21-38 E. 180 feet to the beginning corner.

Being a portion of a lot that was conveyed to the grantor by deed of E. Human, Master for Greenville County dated December 22, 1933 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deeds Volume 173 at page 20.
