by the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents to grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

 all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
 lying and being in the state and County aforesaid,
 Beebe Springs Township, about two and one half miles
 north west of the town of Greer, on the West side of
 the Biuncome Road, adjoining lands of G. H. Gray, Mrs.
 E. J. Westmoreland, and A. P. Owens, and being a part of the
 same land (and being all of the remainder of) conveyed to
 me by deed from Mrs. Elizabeth J. Westmoreland December
 8th 1930, and having the following courses and distances:
 Beginning on a point on the original G. H. Gray line, A.
 P. Owens corner, and runs thence with the Owens line
 S. 25-18 E. 288.5 feet to an iron pin on A. P. Owens line, new
