the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto I said

Saft M. Joseph, and his heirs and assigns forever, All that piece parcel or lot of land, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, in the Town of West Greenville, S.C., that is a portion of lot no 8 of Block A of the Melville Land Company, as shown on Plat recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book A at page 47, being a portion of the same lot conveyed to me by A. H. Lovelace by deed dated April 7, 1930; the portion of said lot herein conveyed is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on Pendleton Street at the corner of said lot with the property of Mrs Cox and running back on line of said lot toward Alston Street 114 feet; thence in a line parallel with Pendleton Street, approximately 53 feet to opposite line of said lot; thence on line of said lot 103 feet to Pendleton Street; thence up Pendleton Street 53.75 feet to beginning corner.

Joseph heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
