All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, about three miles north of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot no 9 of the property of P. G. Gear, as shown on plat of said property recorded in the R. M. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G" page 237, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Arlington Avenue, at a point 360 feet west of the northeast intersection of Arlington and Beacon Streets; going corner lot of and 106 running thence with line of Lot No 10 N. 5-50 W. 150 feet, thence S. 83-55 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5-50 E. 150 feet to another pin on Arlington Avenue, corner of Lot no 8; thence with Arlington Ave. N. 83-55 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The Arlington Avenue hereinabove referred to is also known as Blue Ridge Drive.
