1. All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing Seventy-five (75) acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of F. T. Cox bearing date of December 29, 1919 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 63 at page 127 to which reference is hereby craved for a fuller description as to lines, corners, distances etc.

All of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and containing 5.80 acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of E. S. Armstrong bearing date of December 3, 1919 and recorded in the R. M.
