Beginning at the corner of Markley and Rhett Streets, thence running with the north side of Rhett Street, N. 70 1/2 E. 100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. 18 3/4 E. 70 feet, more or less to a pin on McHugh's line; thence S. 70 1/2 W. 100 feet, more or less, to East side of Markley Street; thence along the East side of Markley Street, S. 18 3/4 E. 70 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, being the same lot which was conveyed to me, the said John S.
