Memorandum of Agreement

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into this November 9th, 1933, between the landlord of the first part, and the tenant of the second part, is as below set forth

The contract is entered into by Corrie Evans, Ben Evans, Wilma Kelly, Maud Ligon and Selma Black as tenants, and Joe Nathan Black as landlord.

The landlord rents to the tenant the thirty-nine (39) acre piece of Ben Evans, occupied during the present year by George Yeargin, this contract being for the year 1934, and the rent agreed upon being one thousand pounds (1000) of good middling cotton, payable October 15th, 1934, and decided by J. K. Huff to Ben Evans, Grand Township.
