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shall be executed and recorded in the same manner as this instrument. This contract, assignment and power of attorney shall not be revoked without the consent of the noteholder and shall remain in force until the mortgage be fully repaid; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect, postpone or otherwise affect the rights and remedies of the noteholder under the mortgage or deed of trust or under the laws of the state in which the property is situated, but on the contrary all such rights and remedies may be pursued by the note holder at any and all times so fully and completely as if this contract, assignment and power of attorney had not been given.

Special Provisions.

It is understood, however, that until there be a default in the payment of any part of the principal, interest, taxes or insurance premiums or in any of the covenants and agreements of the deed securing the loan the owner may exercise all acts of ownership and collect all rents as if this instrument had not been made.

A written notice or statement of any such default as aforesaid signed by the agent or noteholder shall be sufficient evidence to tenants and others that this instrument has become operative in all respects.
